Job Description

The Faculty of Mathematics and Physics is seeking applications for a full-time tenured position for a female at the rank of associate professor or a full-time tenure track (5 years) position for a female at the rank of assistant professor of mathematics, especially in the field of probability, statistics, or analysis, to conduct research and teach undergraduate and graduate students. The successful candidate becomes a member of the group "Research in mathematical sciences and their mathematical foundations for investigating diverse phenomena" at Kanazawa University.

The candidates must have a doctoral and/or Ph. D degree and outstanding research records in the area of probability, statistics, or analysis. The selectee is expected to conduct internationally recognized research, to teach (including Probability Theory) and supervise graduate students of Course in Mathematics.

Application materials (written in Japanese or English on A4 size paper) should include the following:

- (1) Curriculum vitae, including a photo, contact information (phone number, e-mail address), and your desired job category
- (2) List of publications including peer-reviewed original papers, books, talks and etc. (Papers to appear and preprints may be included but the status of such papers (accepted, submitted, preprint, etc.) should be clearly indicated.)
- (3) Offprints or hard copies of five major papers
- (4) Summary of research achievements and prospective research (approximately 2 pages)
- (5) Education achievements and aspirations towards education (classroom, supervision of undergraduate and graduate students) upon appointment (1–2 pages)
- (6) List of competitive research funds obtained to date
- (7) Contact information of two reference persons (name, affiliation, e-mail address, and phone number)
